About Captain Joe Billek & the Captain Billek Foundation

Captain Joe Billek was married to his high school sweetheart with two wonderful sons and a successful career at Tampa Fire Rescue.

Joe developed a tiny mole on his back and was diagnosed with an ulcerated melanoma in May of 2009. He had a wide excision performed with clear margins and no lymph node involvement. A PET scan showed a clean bill of health.

Nine months later, a follow up PET scan showed the melanoma had spread to his right lung and left scapula. Over the next two years, Joe was seen by the top specialists throughout the U.S. and participated in numerous clinical trials. During this time, the melanoma continued to spread to his brain and other very vital organs.

Joe believed that by participating in clinical trials, the information the doctor's could receive from his results would someday help others in their fight - even if the trial did not work for him. He dedicated his life to helping others. He followed in the foot steps of his father - a retiree of FDNY - and served 28 years with Tampa Fire Rescue, retiring with the rank of Captain/ Paramedic.

In the final 18 months of his career, he showed us all how to face adversity with dignity and courage. Captain Billek rose to the challenge of battling melanoma with the same tenacity, determination and drive. He was a true example of what firefighters are.

Joe set an example that we should all hope to live by. He was a husband, father, son, brother, uncle, mentor, and a friend to many. The life lessons that were learned by the many followers of Joe's journey were life changing.

Captain Billek passed away on March 6, 2012 at the age of 51, after a two year fight against melanoma.
